Code of Ethical Conduct

The following standard of conduct should govern the members of the NCIWC in all actions concerned with breeding, selling, exhibiting, owning and protecting this breed. Members should follow the *intent* of this Code even when specific areas are not covered.

NCIWC Members will:

- Demonstrate values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and respectful competition, as well as winning and losing with good grace, both while inside and outside of the show ring.
- Make every effort to educate any new member, owner or prospective owner, being both instructive and constructive in all comments.
- Always behave in a manner that is conducive to the advancement of our breed and of our club.
- Provide the best possible standards of health are for the physical and emotional well-being of their dog(s). This includes, but is not limited to, appropriate food, shelter, sanitation, required immunizations, regular health checks, medical care as needed, and the appropriate attention, exercise and affection at all times.
- Seek to control their dogs at all times, both on and off their own premises, in the form of fencing, leashes, or the appropriate training to effect this control.
- Clean up after your dog at all times and in all locations.
